Glossary	Definition
Originality	Novelty or creativity for rendering distinctive ideas
Learning outcomes	All knowledge, skill, value and attitudes acquired by the learner as a result of going through a specific educational experience, through studying a specific curriculum
Strategies	A group of procedures that a teacher plans to use for teaching a specific topic, in order to achieve the desired edu- cational objectives with the available potentials.
Electronic content	The electronic scientific resources prepared, drafted, produced and spread to enable the student to exercise the skills of searching for and getting information electronically, through creative and cooperative styles in the elec- tronic education environments, in order to realize the electronic learning through acquiring the behavioral chang- es that fit the educational objectives.
Tools of electronic education	All educational, interactive technological tools necessary for the application of electronic education, such as the learning platforms, spreading content, assessment methods and communication tools and monitoring and follow-ing up the educational process.
Institutional communication	The method through which the teacher communicates with the different individuals inside the school: (the school administration, teacher, studentsetc)



Candidacy Controls

Serial number	Candidacy Controls
1	The teacher should be working at any of Jeddah schools (government, private or international schools) when applying for the Award.
2	The candidate must have at least three years' teaching experience .
3	The documents and supporting evidences must be recent and issued within the last three years, inclusive of the year of applying for the Award.
4	Teacher's appraisal scores for the last three years must not be less than 90.
5	The teacher must be known for discipline, good behavior and proper conduct.
6	The teacher's record must be free from any administrative sanction within the last three years, with no current lawsuit against him / her.
7	The participant's file must be in Arabic Documents issued in other languages must have an Arabic translation attached.
8	The teacher may participate with a previously winning project, after the lapse of three years. Supporting evidences and outcomes of the project is provided.
9	All documents submitted must be issued by accredited official authorities and marked as "True Copy" by the school at which the teacher works.
